

Private Applicator Certificates

PACs are renewed every three years, on the following schedule:

Last names A-H: renewal by Dec 2018

Last names I-Q: renewal by Dec 2019

Last names R-Z: renewal by Dec 2020

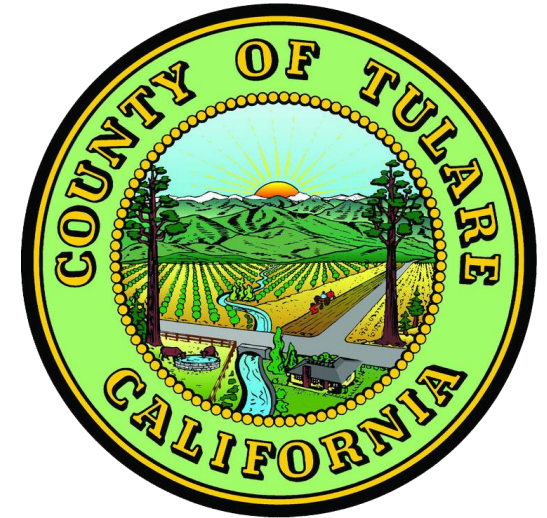
A total of six Continuing Education (CE) hours, over the three years, may be used to renew a PAC. Hours are prorated if the PAC is held for less than the three-year cycle. **At least two of the six CE hours must be in Laws and Regulations.** Certificate holders may retest by written exam in lieu of obtaining CE hours.

Private Applicator

A private applicator certificate is required for anyone applying for a restricted materials pesticide permit, intends to apply pesticides themselves and doesn't hold a QAL or QAC.

Qualified Applicator

A person that is licensed under the California Qualified Applicator Licensing program, such as QAL or QAC.

- Private Applicator Certificate holders shall complete continuing education requirements during the time the certificate is valid, or retake and pass the examination.
- A minimum of 2 hours in Laws are required. Certificates valid from 12-24 months at time of renewal shall have completed 4 hours of CE. Certificates valid from 24-36 months at time of renewal shall have completed 6 hours of CE.



Credit Hours Available

- Continuing Education courses are approved for 2 hours of Laws & Regs and 0.5 hours of Other.
- Courses are not repeatable for additional credit.
