CHLORPYRIFOS DESIGNATED AS A RESTRICTED MATERIAL **EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015**

The Department of Pesticide Regulation is designating pesticides containing chlorpyrifos as the active ingredient as California Restricted Materials when labeled for the production of an agricultural commodity. The regulation becomes effective on July 1, 2015.

Growers wishing to use chlorpyrifos (products such as Lorsban, Dursban, Lock-On, Govern 4E, etc.) on their property must add it to their Restricted Materials Permit for all crops on which they intend to apply chlorpyrifos. Supplemental forms to add chlorpyrifos to the permit can be completed at any Tulare County Agricultural Commissioner office during regular business hours.

Reminder to pesticide permit holders: Provide a copy of the permit supplement to the Pest Control Dealership from whom you purchase your pesticides and to any Pest Control Businesses who do pesticide applications for you.
