To whom it may concern,

To comply with Section 6270.5 below as it pertains to CalAgPermits – an enterprise system utilized by CAC's in all counties, the catalog entries below may be utilized for posting on every County's website:

1. Vendor: California County Solutions, LLC ("CaliCo Solutions")
2. System Product: Data records pertaining to pesticide permitting and pesticide usage in Tulare County.
3. System Purpose: To provide an integrated data management system that allows county pesticide regulators to:
 - a) Prepare, issue, and manage Restricted Materials Permits and Operator Identification Numbers.
 - b) Collect and manage agricultural and non-agricultural pesticide usage reports.
 - c) Register licensed pest control businesses.
4. Categories of Data:
 - a) Contacts, locations of agricultural operations, identity and locations of commodities grown or treated, and pesticide use and handling conditions compiled in Restricted Materials Permits and Operator Identification Number records.
 - b) Pesticide Usage Reports, including the application date/time, location, applicator identity, commodities treated, pesticide product and amount applied, and application method for all reportable applications of pesticides.
 - c) Contact and licensing information for pest control businesses and agricultural operators doing business in Tulare County.
5. Custodian: Tulare County Agricultural Commissioner
6. Data Collection Frequency: constant
7. Data Update Frequency: constant

SEC. 2.

Section 6270.5 is added to the Government Code, to read:

6270.5.

(a) In implementing this chapter, each local agency, except a local educational agency, shall create a catalog of enterprise systems. The catalog shall be made publicly available upon request in the office of the person or officer designated by the agency's legislative body. The catalog shall be posted in a prominent location on the local agency's Internet Web site, if the agency has an Internet Web site. The catalog shall disclose a list of the enterprise systems utilized by the agency and, for each system, shall also disclose all of the following:

- (1) Current system vendor.
- (2) Current system product.
- (3) A brief statement of the system's purpose.
- (4) A general description of categories or types of data.
- (5) The department that serves as the system's primary custody
- (6) How frequently system data is collected.
- (7) How frequently system data is updated.
