Application Checklists

1. Grower Application packet check list

- CDFA Registration
- Tulare County Permit
 - i. Cultivation site numbers, latitudes, and longitudes must correspond to those stated on the CDFA Registration.
 - 1. For example, Site # 1 with a latitude: 36.166332 and longitude: -119.329114 on the CDFA Registration must be Site # 1 with a latitude: 36.166332 and longitude: -119.329114 on the Tulare County Permit.
- Key Participants' Criminal History Reports
 - i. FBI Identity History Summary

- Documents required to meet 3 CCR 4920
 - i. Certified seed is not required, but if you are using certified seed, you must provide the certified seed label.
 - ii. For hemp cultivated in California
 - 1. Proof Registration with the cover letter issued by the Agricultural Commissioner of the County where the hemp was cultivated.
 - 2. Unredacted copy of the laboratory results required by law/regulation that allowed the grower of that seed to harvest that seed.
 - iii. For hemp cultivated in another State in the United States
 - 1. Proof Registration from the State where the hemp was cultivated
 - 2. Unredacted laboratory results that states that the hemp cultivated meets a delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of no more than 0.3 percent on a dry weight basis. Delta-9-THC must be a post-decarboxylation value or a calculated value using a conversion formula based on 3 CCR 4944.
 - iv. Refer to 3 CCR 4920 for requirements for hemp cultivated as part of a pilot program, or not cultivated in the United States.
- Map of each growing site showing boundaries of your Industrial Hemp growing areas by Industrial Hemp Cultivar and setbacks as stated in the ordinance.
- Check of \$900 to CDFA Cashier
- Permit fees apply
- Notarized consent (if leasing property).
- Financial Security of \$1000 per site plus \$100 per acre (if leasing property).

2. Breeder Application packet check list

- CDFA Registration
- Tulare County Permit
 - i. Cultivation site numbers, latitudes, and longitudes must correspond to those stated on the CDFA Registration.

- Variety Development Plan
 - i. Seed-certifying agency if applicable
 - ii. Name of varieties used and, if applicable, how they will be used in the development of a new cultivar
 - iii. Plan for testing all of the plants grown
 - iv. The measures they will take to destroy any plants with THC concentrations that test above 0.3 percent
 - v. The measures that will be taken to prevent the unlawful use of IH under this division
 - vi. Procedure for documenting the development of the new cultivar
- Map of each growing site showing boundaries of your Industrial Hemp growing areas by Industrial Hemp Cultivar and setbacks as stated in the ordinance.
- Check of \$900 to CDFA Cashier
- Permit fees apply
- Notarized consent (if leasing property).
- Financial Security of \$1000 per site plus \$100 per acre (if leasing property).
