Tulare County will begin renewal of Pesticide Permits/Private Applicator Certificates on
October 1, 2020.

This is in response to Covid-19 and needing to limit capacity, please plan to renew early.

Please bring:

1. A completed version of our new **Permit Application** in order to help our Department serve you better. (attached)
2. A completed version of the **Alternatives and Mitigations** you will consider if you have a **Restricted Materials Permit**. (attached if RMP)
3. A copy of your permit with any new additions, corrections, and/or updates.
4. A complete set of site **Maps** showing nearby roads, houses, surrounding crops, schools etc.
5. A **Letter of Authorization** for representatives to make changes or sign the permit if not previously done in the past few years.

*All current Letters of Authorizations are still valid until revoked by the property operator.

Private Applicator Certification (PAC) is required for Restricted Material Permit applicants and those using federally restricted products. PAC's with last names beginning with **R-Z** expire on **12/31/2020**. Renewal of PAC's will require 6 hours of Continuing Education.

(2 hours of which must be Laws and Regulations)

If you would like to renew your Certificate with Continuing Education hours, bring copies of your class attendance with you when you come in for Permit renewal.

PAC Exams:

Private Applicator exams will be available on a walk-in basis. Tests will be available from 8:00A.M – 3:00P.M., Monday through Friday, at the Tulare County Agricultural Commissioner's Office Auditorium located at 4437 South Laspina St. Tulare, CA 93274
